Although the new year's festivities will soon be upon us, the Decoration Committee has tried to represent the event all around the Principality.



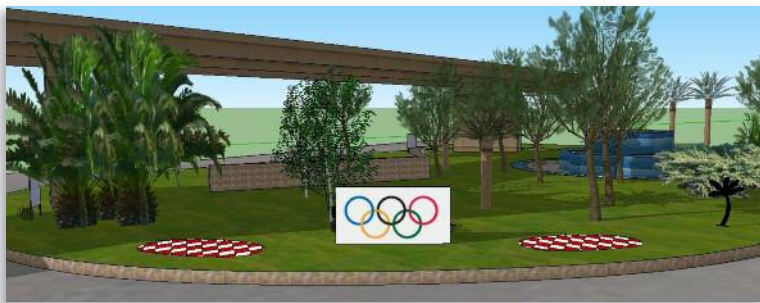
All the main places (Fairmont Hotel, Grimaldi Forum, Avenue Princesse Grace and the Monaco Convention Centre and Auditorium) are decorated with the Olympic colours : 127<sup>th</sup> IOC Session and Olympic rings pavilions and flags will emphasise the importance of this event.



Rue Grimaldi, Boulevard Albert I<sup>er</sup>, Avenue Albert II, and Boulevard Larvotto will be decorated with kakemonos and tent-clothes on the footbridges. Thanks to the support of the UCAM (Union des Commerçants et Artisans de Monaco), posters are also displayed in the city Lux network and in the shops.



To make the Session even more impressive, the Department of Urban Amenities has decorated the Grimaldi Forum basins and the Portier roundabout with flowers.



Besides the various museums mentioned in the brochures, the Principality of Monaco invites you to visit its Christmas Village themed "Christmas on the Rooftops" and organised by the Monaco City Hall.



The magic of Christmas arrives every year at "Quai Albert I<sup>er</sup>" starting with the first week of December. Artefacts have a place of choice in the chalet shops as do regional gastronomic specialties in the food chalets. However, it has been the desire of Town Hall, ever since the creation of the Christmas Village in 1999, that it be not merely a commercial venue but rather a place guaranteeing a change of scenery where yearly new decorations and thematic activities, selected by the City's Events Department, carry children and adults alike to an enchanted world.

✓ Visit of the Parfumerie Fragonard, perfume Museum, where you will be invited to discover the secrets of perfume manufacturing.

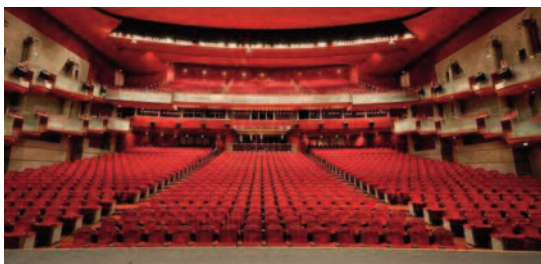
✓ If the weather is fine, stroll in the old town's streets.

The **Opening Ceremony** of the 127<sup>th</sup> IOC Session will take place in the Salle des Princes at the Grimaldi Forum on December 7<sup>th</sup>.

- Olympic anthem by “les Choeurs de l’Opéra de Monte-Carlo”.

- Address by H.S.H. the Prince Albert II, President of the Monaco Olympic Committee and Member of the IOC.
- Address by Mr Thomas BACH, President of the IOC.
- Performance of “Vers un Pays Sage” by “Les Ballets de Monte-Carlo”.

Created in 1995, Vers un Pays sage (Towards a Wise Country) is one of Jean-Christophe Maillot’s most iconic ballet works, to the point that the press has hailed the piece – which has grown ever more beautiful over time – a masterpiece. The choreographic piece, toured the world over, has become emblematic of the artistic identity of Les Ballets de Monte-Carlo.

## A stamp created specially for the 127<sup>th</sup> IOC Session

The Stamp Issuing Office of the Principality of Monaco has created the 127<sup>th</sup> IOC Session's logo. From December 1st, the Stamp Issuing Office will issue a special stamp for this event.

The stamp will be sold at the Principality’s Stamps Office, the Stamp and Coin Museum, post offices and philatelic desks, in the shops of stamp traders and at the Post Museum and the Carré d’Encre in Paris.

In 1937, the collector’s demand by correspondence concerning the stamps of Monaco led to the creation of a "Stamp Issuing Office", Monegasque administrative department next to the French postal service on the territory.

This Office is also in charge to conceive the Monegasque stamp issuing policy and to propose the drawings to a Commission located in the Palace. Since 1949 and the accession to the throne of the Prince Rainier III, the Sovereign decides, personally and at the suggestion of the Director of the O.E.T.P., subjects, drawings and proofs of colors, which He signs and which are integrated into the Princely Collection, one of the most prestigious in the world, because it concentrates all the documents connected to the stamps issues, which are often spread between several services in the other countries.

The Stamp Issuing Office established a system of subscription - precursor at that time - and has nowadays 20.000 customers by correspondence. The customers, initially Monegasque or French, extend in Europe and a bigger diversification is permitted with the Internet site.

In the International Postal Institutions, the Principality is represented by the permanent Delegate to the International Organizations and by the Director of the O.E.T.P. (admission in Universal Postal Union in 1955 and PostEurop in 1993).



The Agreement of May 18 1963 governs "postal, telegraphic and phone relations" between France and Monaco. However, abolition of the telegraph and privatization of the telephone (1996) partially emptied that Agreement of its purpose. A contract for postal concession is being studied.

Beside the stamps of Monaco or the "prêt à poster" (only 2 envelopes during the administration of H.S. H. Prince Rainier III, in 1997 and in 1999), issued by the O.E.T.P., the Post Office of Monaco uses self-adhesive labels and different specific postal products and boxes, similar to those used by the French postal system but with colors or illustrations of Monaco, whereas numerous companies use mechanical postal means.

This evolution certainly is inevitable because of time and staff saving. Nevertheless, envelopes franked with stamps raise a particular interest of the addressee and contribute to the prestige of Monaco.
