The **Opening Ceremony** of the 127th IOC Session will take place in the Salle des Princes at the Grimaldi Forum on December 7th.



Programme:

- Olympic anthem by "les Choeurs de l'Opéra de Monte-Carlo".
- National anthem by "les Choeurs de l'Opéra de Monte-Carlo".
- Address by H.S.H. the Prince Albert II, President of the Monaco Olympic Committee and Member of the IOC.
- Address by Mr Thomas BACH, President of the IOC.
- Performance of "Vers un Pays Sage" by "Les Ballets de Monte-Carlo".

Created in 1995, Vers un Pays sage (Towards a Wise Country) is one of Jean-Christophe Maillot's most iconic ballet works, to the point that the press has hailed the piece – which has grown ever more beautiful over time – a masterpiece. The choreographic piece, toured the world over, has become emblematic of the artistic identity of Les Ballets de Monte-Carlo.

A stamp created specially for the 127th IOC Session

The Stamp Issuing Office of the Principality of Monaco has created the 127th IOC Session's logo. From December 1st, the Stamp Issuing Office will issue a special stamp for this event.

The stamp will be sold at the Principality's Stamps Office, the Stamp and Coin Museum, post offices and philatelic desks, in the shops of stamp traders and at the Post Museum and the Carré d'Encre in Paris.

In 1937, the collector's demand by correspondence concerning the stamps of Monaco led to the creation of a "Stamp Issuing Office", Monegasque administrative department next to the French postal service on the territory.

This Office is also in charge to conceive the Monegasque stamp issuing policy and to propose the drawings to a Commission located in the Palace. Since 1949 and the accession to the throne of the Prince Rainier III, the Sovereign decides, personally and at the suggestion of the Director of the O.E.T.P., subjects, drawings and proofs of colors, which He signs and which are integrated into the Princely Collection, one of the most prestigious in the world, because it concentrates allthe documents connected to the stamps issues, which are often spread between several services in the other countries.

The Stamp Issuing Office established a system of subscription - precursor at that time - and has nowadays 20.000 customers by correspondence. The customers, initially Monegasque or French, extend in Europe and a bigger diversification is permitted with the Internet site.

In the International Postal Institutions, the Principality is represented by the permanent Delegate to the International Organizations and by the Director of the O.E.T.P. (admission in Universal Postal Union in 1955 and PostEurop in 1993).



The Agreement of May 18 1963 governs "postal, telegraphic and phone relations" between France and Monaco. However, abolition of the telegraph and privatization of the telephone (1996) partially emptied that Agreement of its purpose. A contract for postal concession is being studied.

Beside the stamps of Monaco or the "prêt à poster " (only 2 envelopes during the administration of H.S. H. Prince Rainier III, in 1997 and in 1999), issued by the O.E.T.P., the Post Office of Monaco uses self-adhesive labels and different specific postal products and boxes, similar to those used by the French postal system but with colors or illustrations of Monaco, whereas numerous companies use mechanical postal means.

This evolution certainly is inevitable because of time and staff saving. Nevertheless, envelopes franked with stamps raise a particular interest of the addressee and contribute to the prestige of Monaco.
